

The Violence Reduction Network (VRN) and Leicestershire Police's new campaign for young people aged under 25, across Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland (LLR).

The 'Make A Stand Against Violence' campaign aims to support young people to help prevent violence, by encouraging them to look after their mates.

## The Campaign So Far...

The campaign launched in Spring and has been a huge success in engaging young people, achieving:

- 2 million impressions
- 15,000+ engagements on social media content
- 4,000+ visitors to the website
- 250,000 30-second views of the 'bystander' video on YouTube

# **About The Campaign**

Violence comes in many forms. Make a Stand Against Violence helps young people to understand what violence can look like and aims to tackle harmful behaviours such as bullying or physical fighting before they escalate.

The campaign focuses on **providing young** people with the tools to be an 'active bystander'

- by taking action to look after their mates and safely de-escalating harmful situations.









They can do this in one of the following ways:

- **Cool it down** (e.g., distract a mate)
- Be direct (e.g., say it's not ok)
- **Get help** (during or after the situation)

The campaign has two elements. **The first element** showcases real-life examples of when young people have looked after their mates.

**The second element** is all about providing young people with the knowledge of how to be an active bystander - taking action to look after their mates. This element features young people from across LLR in a video giving advice on what other young people can do, to de-escalate harmful situations.
